Bookings

UK Coaching Certificate

The UK Coaching Certificate (UKCC) is a national initiative to endorse coach education programmes across sports throughout the UK against agreed criteria. For sports clubs, the UKCC will mean that the coaches you bring into your club, or the members whom you train as coaches, will have been trained to a recognised standard of competency. For parents, this also means that whoever is coaching their children will have been properly prepared to provide appropriate coaching. Sports Coach UK is the national agency responsible for the overall development of the scheme and within each sport it is the relevant National Governing Body that is responsible for the development and delivery of coach education programmes within that sport.

Coach Education Grants

Grants are available to assist with the costs of becoming a qualified coach for people who do not already fit the reduced fee criteria.
